Concerts

He performed a Bach Prelude and Fugue, Beethoven's Sonata Opus 13 in its entirety, *The Man I Love* and *I Got Rhythm* by George Gerswin, and *Regard de l'Étoile* from *Vingt Regards sur l'Enfant-Jésus* by Messiaen. The second concert was held during the afternoon, and all my students were invited to participate. This was the first time we had come to this venue and it has a very good Blüthner Grand Piano. Additional to those named above we heard from *Luca Cambden, Matthew Kimemia, Elena Margetis, Paul Studart* and *Eleanor Wilson*.

Music Festivals

Many students took part in Music Festivals, in particular the **Blackheath Music Festival** of which I am Piano Secretary. Students achieved 'Merit', 'Commended', 'Distinction' and 'Outstanding' awards for their performances. The *Duet with Teacher Classes* proved particularly popular, maybe because these are noncompetitive classes. Congratulations to *Anežka Butler, Olivia Petrie, Florence Hyde, Jerry Hamilton, Anto Buckley, Rosanna Wood, Eleanor Wilson* and *Isabel Biddle. Rebecca Kadi* played in both the *Grade 7 Class* and the *16 Years and Over Class*. In 2013 **Tony Seprenji** achieved **First Place** in what is probably the most advanced Class of the Festival, the *Open Recital Class*. He played music by Brahms, Rachmaninov, Beethoven and Messiaen. Tony also performed Bach in the *Baroque Music Class* as well as music by Chopin and Messiaen in the *16/17 year old Class* at the **Maidstone Music Festival**. He was awarded 'Outstanding' in both categories. *Michael Riley* achieved **First Place** in the *Grade 8 Class* at both the **Beckenham Music Festival** and the **Maidstone Music Festival**. He achieved the 'Outstanding' category in the *16/17 Years Recital Class*. *Gareth Clarridge* and *Owen Clarridge* were awarded 'Merit' and 'Commended' in the *Grade 6 Class* and also in the *14/15* and *16/17 year old Classes* respectively.
